A recording fee of .50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the Show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the same show, the recording fee will be collected on the first entry only. (AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB rules, Chapter 14, Section 2)

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the actions of the Show Committee. Bitches in season are not eligible for competition and will not be permitted on the grounds and entry fees will not be refunded in any case. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators.
